How to raise money.....

The Examiner Charity Challenge 2010 is an opportunity for people to raise money for many different charities. Last year's event raised over £35,000 and this is a challenge to beat that figure!

There are 13 charities for you to choose from and, of course, the chance to raise funds for a **charity of your own choice**. Please indicate this at box 14 on the form overleaf.

Whether you decide to enjoy our beautiful countryside walking or Nordic Walking, riding your bike or horse or taking part in on the wheelchair or pushchair route, it's a chance for healthy exercise and to have the satisfaction of raising money for a number of worthwhile charities.

How to enter.....

To take part, fill in the form overleaf and return it to the Examiner's Queen Street South address.

Each entrant will receive a sponsorship form which gives you the chance to ask family and friends to sponsor you. Bring the sponsorship form along with you on Sunday, May 23 to register at Meltham Sports and Community Centre, Mean Lane, Meltham or at Beaumont Park for the wheelchair and pushchair routes and the horse route from the Crossroads Inn, Snowgatehead, New Mill.

People over 16 will be charged £3.00 and 6-16 year-olds will pay £1.00 which goes towards the cost of administering the event with the remainder going to the Lions Clubs' charities. Children under 6 will be able to enter for nothing.

If you miss the closing date for the return of the entry forms (Friday, April 30) you can turn up on the day and pay £10 (£5 of which will be refunded on return to the registration desk) to the Lions Clubs' charities. (No late entries will be accepted on the horse ride, Nordic Walk or 20K Walk).
